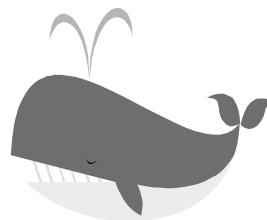

HYMN NOTES

Holy God, We Praise Thy Name—Ignaz Franz, 1719-1790 (*Today's Sermon Hymn, bulletin pg. 9*) The early church "Te Deum Laudamus" is one the great hymns of praise, creed, and supplication. Written in 1774, Franz's hymn is a German paraphrase of the "Te Deum." Written for a Catholic hymnal, it is equally loved and sung by Protestants to the German melody GROSSER GOTT. This hymn was played as President Kennedy's casket was carried out of St. Matthew's Cathedral in Washington, D.C.

ANTHEM

I Bind Unto Myself Today

By: St. Patrick

The anthem this morning takes place during communion. If you'd like to follow along, the words and music are found in the hymnal in the pew, Hymn #172. I Bind Unto Myself Today is one of the oldest hymns in our hymnal. The text is attributed to St. Patrick who lived between 372 and 466 A.D.
