- Please turn off any cell phones, pagers, beepers, and other audible electronic devices.

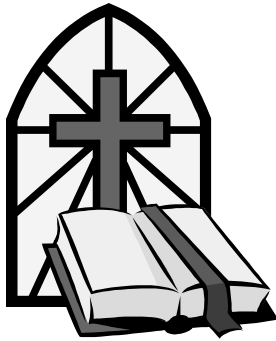
Adult Information Class

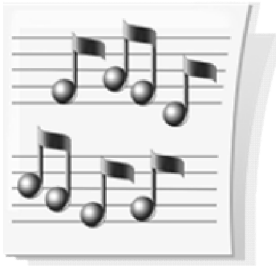
We hope you feel as good about yourself as those hundreds of children who will have new underwear and socks, many for the first time.

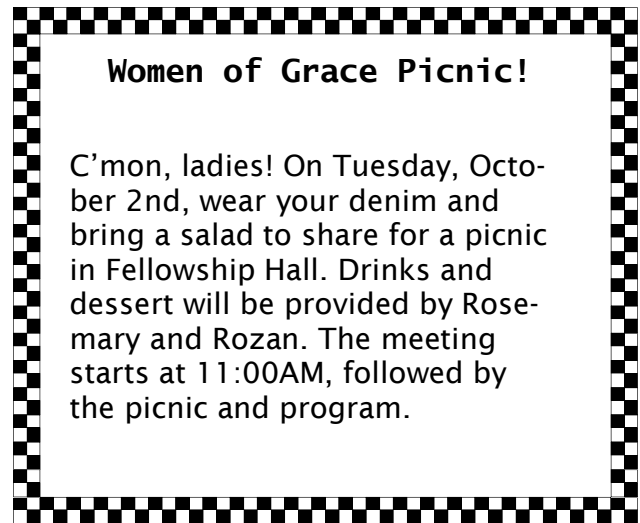


Hymn Notes
